

Application for Global Citizenship Diploma at Global High Schools

The diplomas will be awarded in April each year. All students at Global High Schools (HF, IB, STX, HTX) can apply every year in March. A maximum of 5 awards will be issued per school.

To apply for a *Global Citizenship Diploma* you must describe at least two activities. Together the activities you describe must fulfill the requirements in each of the three global dimensions mentioned below. Meaning that an activity can count in more than one dimension, but does not have to do so. Travel is not required and extracurricular activities in the broader community will also count. The application can be written in either Danish or English.

The form must be completed and emailed to the Global High School Coordinator at your school no later than April. A selection committee of the Global High School Coordinator and the Global High Schools Project Manager will consider the applications, and if approved issue the diplomas. In case of doubts the selection committee will require further details and/or documentation.

The diplomas will be handed over by the Headmaster at the graduation.
